Stuyvesant, along with all students in grades 6 through 12 (outside of District 75 schools) will continue to learn remotely until further notice. Read the Chancellor's Update for Families dated November 29. Mandatory weekly in-school testing for COVID-19 will be in place in all reopened buildings for all blended learners and staff members when we reopen. Families may submit consent using a parents' NYCSA account at mystudent.nyc or the updated paper consent form. Directions on how to consent in the NYCSA account are on the Parent Info page at www.stuy.edu. Email ringram3@schools.nyc.gov for assistance with NYCSA accounts. A printable PDF file is available in ten languages at schools.nyc.gov/covidtesting. Students who do not submit consent will be transitioned to remote only learning. Students who have recently traveled outside of New York to a place on the State's travel advisory list must quarantine for 14 days or have the option of testing out of quarantine based on the State's guidelines. Staff are also required to provide consent by the first day they report to their school building. Staff may submit consent using the daily Health Questionnaire or using this paper form.

We will host two December sessions of **Coffee & Conversation with Mr. Yu** for parents and guardians on **Wednesdays**, **December 9 and 16 at 8:30-9:30am**. You may <u>sign up at this link</u> for the lottery to attend these small sessions of 25 parents. **We will close the signup form on Monday at 5pm November 30** and notify families by December 4. Topics will be posted one week before the meetings and emailed to those attending.
