

While today is the first day back to blended learning for *elementary* schools in New York City, all middle and high school students will continue fully remote learning until further notice. The Chancellor and Mayor released *NEW* Blended Learning Guidance mandating COVID testing for all students returning to school buildings as well as staff members. Families may submit consent using a parents' NYCSA account at <u>mystudent.nyc</u> or the <u>updated paper consent form.</u> There are instructional videos and information on how to consent in your account <u>here</u>. Email <u>ringram3@schools.nyc.gov</u> for assistance with NYCSA accounts. A printable PDF file is available in ten languages at schools.nyc.gov/covidtesting. *Students who do not submit consent will be transitioned to remote only learning.*

The deadline for **CR requests** for passing grades from Spring 2019-2020 and Summer School was November 30. Going Forward, requests entered via parent Talos accounts for CR grades should ONLY be for **resolved NX** grades. That deadline is March 1, 2021. <u>Follow instructions to file a request</u>.
