What We Do

ARISTA is Stuyvesant High School's Honor Society. We strive to proudly serve our community as role models and leaders of the future. By participating in school events, volunteering with outside organizations, and tutoring students both at Stuyvesant and throughout the city, we uphold the four pillars of ARISTA: Character, Leadership, Scholarship, and Service. Outside of our membership, we provide many services for all Stuyvesant students seeking academic support across all subject areas.

Peer Tutoring

ARISTA members that have expertise in a given subject conduct one-on-one tutoring with Stuyvesant students. Tutoring sessions can take place during free/lunch periods, after school, during the weekend, and during any breaks. This year, all tutoring sessions are virtual. Students in any grade can request a tutor on our website and the time frame for each session is flexible.

Office Hours

Group tutoring sessions for underclassmen led by ARISTA members occur weekly in almost all subjects. This year, we created Office Hours as a replacement for in-person AIS instruction. Students can visit our website to access the Zoom sessions with no sign-ups required.

Events

ARISTA members have many opportunities to do service inside and outside of Stuyvesant. Having adapted to the virtual environment, our 200+ members can be found transcribing records for the Smithsonian museum, writing cards to US troop members, conversing with senior citizens over the phone through our Phone Angels program, phone banking for Invisible Hands, a COVID relief organization, interning for a City Counsel campaigner, and so much more.

Credit Requirements

ARISTA members are inducted this school year but start earning credits for the first semester of the following year. Freshmen inducted into the Sophomore Program do not have any tutoring requirements but must complete 10 hours of events volunteering each semester.
