We are glad to be back in the building today, Monday, November 16, however, Chancellor Carranza directed schools and families should be prepared for a system-wide shutdown if the COVID test positivity 7-day average reaches 3%. Today's schedule for locker cleanout and textbook return for homerooms L and M is still in effect, and we'll move forward this week as long as school is open and circumstances are safe. We will send updates as soon as further information is available. Should schools switch to fully remote, there are no changes to student class schedules other than attending remotely from home; students will attend classes synchronously and asynchronously with their Stuyvesant teachers as our exception model was designed to transition back and forth between blended and remote instruction. We will email families and post on our school's website news boxes, the Talos Blog and our Official Stuyvesant social media as well as cross communicate through the PA and the Student Union.

We hope that all who engaged in <u>Parent Teacher Conferences</u> this past week had enjoyable and informative conversations with teachers and counselors. We recognize that there may have been some delays with some interpretation requests as the DOE services were overwhelmed at times and apologize for any inconvenience. For those parents/guardians who were not able to make requests for calls through Talos by the November 8 deadline, please reach out to teachers using the <u>staff email list</u> to request updates regarding your child's progress. Any who made rerquests who were not assigned in the alotted times, teachers were given lists to contact during their normal outreach in the coming weeks. This can be via email or other forms.

The 'window of opportunity' to opt into blended learning closed on November 15. We expect to be in touch for blended learning to begin for these students by December 1.
