employment program. Participants will participate in a paid project-based learning

experience, along with career exploration, work-readiness training, leadership

projects and skills development. They will have the opportunity to engage with

employers and build a career network through mentoring, career panels, social

media workshops, and more. Participants will work 18 hours per week for five

weeks, and will earn between \$700 - \$1,000 for the summer.

Students who have already applied to SYEP earlier in the spring must log into their

existing accounts and select a provider & register for this new model by

Wednesday, July 15. Students applying for the first time must complete and submit

their applications by July 15.

Eligible: All students 14 and older who are legally allowed to work in the U.S.

Selection will be by lottery.

Dates: Five weeks in July and August (18 hours of work per week)

Application Deadline: July 15
