

This week, we expect to welcome blended learners back to Stuyvesant on Thursday, October 1 with Group A. The Fall Term calendar has been updated. Please check for the readjusted Group start dates. Talos will be updating on Tuesday, September 29 with information on students' learning mode, seat and location. A <u>Permission Slip</u> to leave the building should a student arrive on the wrong day is required; without this form, a parent or guardian will need to come to Stuyvesant to pick up the child.

Blended families who've returned from out-of-state should pay careful attention to <u>New York's Travel Advisory FAQ</u> & guidelines. Any Blended student returning from one of currently 33 states on <u>this list</u> should attend school retmotely until 14 days from the date of their return to New York State.

Staff and students coming to the building will be required to complete a health screening everyday. Use the <u>Online Health Screening Tool</u> and view helpful videos in <u>English</u>, <u>Spanish</u>. or <u>Chinese</u> on how to complete it.

Students returning to school should bring their Stuy ID's. If your Student ID was lost or stolen, <u>submit the form now</u> to pick up a new one in room 209. Incoming students will be photographed in small batches and should bring a printed copy of their Talos schedule or show their Talos student dashboard on their phone to enter. Once they have their ID; they may view <u>CAASS scanning procedures</u> on the Talos Document Hub under "guides".

Those who need to apply for <u>LIRR student discounts</u> may find forms on the school website. Metrocards will be distributed to qulified blended learners the first day they are in the building.

All blended learners should register their device to use Stuyvesant's WiFI <u>using the "Argus" tab on their Talos dashboard</u>. Detailed instructions are on the Document Hub.
